



# SAUBLE BEACH BENCH PLAQUES POLICY

## POLICY

**Goals:** The Friends of Sauble Beach has initiated a program to produce and secure plaques to beach benches for the following purposes:

- \* to allow members of the Sauble Beach community to donate a bench for general use of the public and **Commemorate** a special event (milestone birthday, wedding or anniversary); **Honour** a family or individual; **Memorialize** a loved one
- \* to raise funds to continue the work of dune management at Sauble Beach;

**Cost:** The plaques will be offered to the public for a donation of \$500.00;

**Bench Maintenance:** The Friends of Sauble Beach transfers the ownership of the benches to the Town of South Bruce Peninsula upon placement on the beach. At that point, bench maintenance becomes the responsibility of the Town.

**Plaque Reserve Fund:** will be established with funds from the donations to cover 100% of the replacement value of the plaque due to vandalism for a period of three years following installation. Following that period, the responsibility for replacing a damaged plaque will revert to the donor.

**Plaque:** ! A cast bronze plaque 3" X 5" in size will be the standard;  
! The maximum number of lines will be three (3) with a maximum of twenty-four (24) characters per line in a 24 point font;  
! The design and wording of each plaque to be approved by the Friends of Sauble Beach;

**Availability:** The plaques will be ordered once a year and be available for installation by the Summer of the following year;

**Location:** Benches will be placed only on the beach at beach access points, not in the dunes and the Friends of Sauble Beach in co-operation of the Town will do their best to guarantee the placement of plaqued benches as specified by the donor(s) on a first come first serve basis;

**Payment:** Cheques shall be made payable to the Town of South Bruce Peninsula and a Tax Receipt will be issued by the Town of South Bruce Peninsula.
